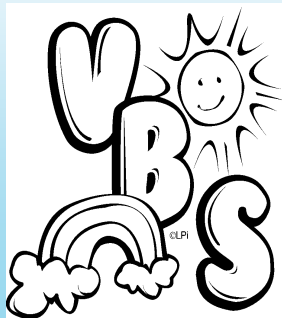

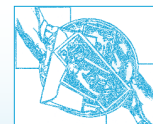
## Vacation Bible School is Coming

- ✦ Bottles & sippy cups - NEW only

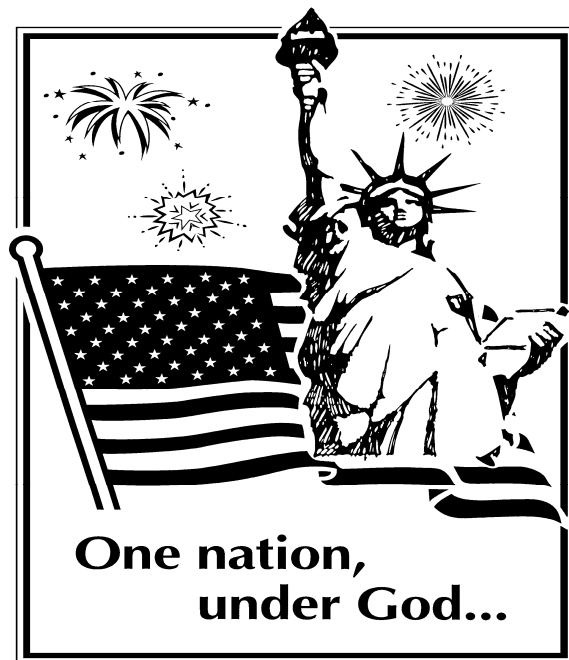
