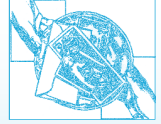

Birthline. . .

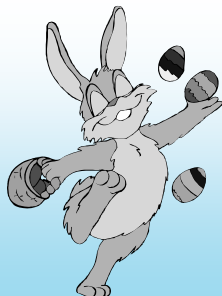
