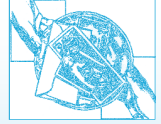

## Stewardship of Time & Talent...

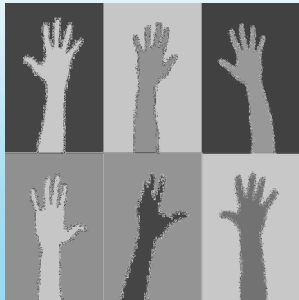
