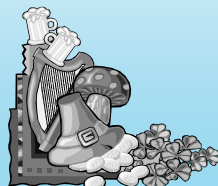

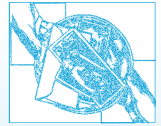
Irish Fest. . .

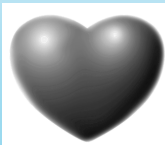
