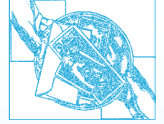

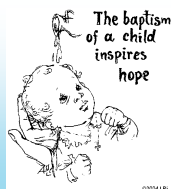
Help for Hurting Marriages. . .

Adult Education Offerings. . .

There are several studies being offered to help you learn more about your faith and study scripture. The U.S. *Catholic Catechism* classes begin again on January 12th. We are now in the Sunday Gospel cycle for St. Luke, and there will be a Bible study on his Gospel beginning January 11th. If you could not attend the Sunday study of *Women in the New Testament*, a block of weekly classes on this book will begin January 13th. You may attend classes offered at 10 a.m. or 7 p.m. For further details and book information, see the bulletin board in the narthex.

Family Life Program. . .

The Church has good news to proclaim about the family and about human love and sexuality. This good news is important for our children to learn as they are bombarded with many mixed messages from contemporary culture, media, and a variety of powerful voices. Catholic sexuality education helps one to understand that sexuality is a gift from God, a precious dimension of human life that requires reverence and care. It sets forth the call to chastity and recognizes the critical importance of the family and particularly parents in the education of their children in human sexuality. Unless the family instills the right attitudes, unless the root values and beliefs of the faith are established in the early years of childhood development in the home, other forms of Christian education can scarcely be effective.

In helping parents with this critically important responsibility, the Archdiocese of Indianapolis is implementing revisions to the guidelines for chastity and sexuality education in our schools and faith formation programs. Our parish faith formation program will be implementing Benziger *Family Life* series to provide catechesis on sexuality for children in grades 5-8. This series has been approved by the United States Catholic Conference of Bishops for both content and methodology. The role and responsibility of parents in the education of their children regarding faith and sexuality is critical.

All parents of students enrolled in grades 5-8 are invited to a Parent Meeting to be held on January 10 in the Parish Hall from 1 pm to 2 pm. The program and outline of the curriculum will be discussed, and an explanation of the role of parents will be given. Your presence at this meeting is very important as your witness is critical in the education of your children.
