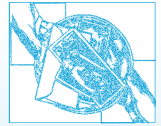
## Loaves & Fishes Food Drive. . .

### MQP Youth Fish Fry. . .

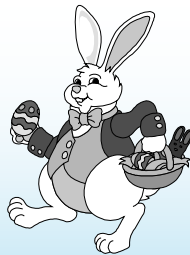
The youth group sponsored Lenten fish fries will begin on Friday, February 27th from 4:30 p.m. till 7:00 p.m. Please join us in the lower level.
